

# Greetings all!

The Grapevine Group is resuming in-person meetings on Sunday September 20th.

The church has given us a list of protocols to follow for us to resume meetings as guests in their facility.

- Masks are mandatory inside the building
- Contact tracing requires that each attendee leave their name and number. These lists will be kept in a sealed, dated envelope by the group itself and only released to the church in the event of an infection. The lists will not include the purpose of your visit to the church and will be destroyed after 14 days.
- The group is responsible for cleaning after each meeting. We ask that all who attend leave the meeting room and church immediately after the meeting to allow this to proceed as quickly as possible. Please feel free to chat as long as you like in the parking lot!
- The format is pretty much the same. Group members will be given personal copies of the Grapevine to read from only. The other readings are laminated and will be sanitized and placed on chairs to be read in their entirety by one person, then placed under their chair. We will no longer split into smaller groups for discussion.
- the seventh will be in a container on the table outside the meeting room with a bit of sanitizer in the bottom.
- Only the handicap washroom will be available, and the kitchen will be closed.
- Maximum capacity is 25 people.

If you feel uncomfortable or disagree with any of the church policies, feel free to not attend the meeting. These are public health guidelines that the church must follow, and the Grapevine group must adhere to as guests. They are not open to debate.
